Part 1 - Analysis of Language Use Lecture: You will develop your ability to understand and present your analysis about how points of view are presented in both written and visual texts. Building on your existing language analysis knowledge, this session will reinforce how to write a response that is controlled and employs language that is specific to the assessment criteria. **Part 2 - Exam Text Response Lecture:** This powerful lecture will build your confidence in writing structured, developed and coherent arguments that use detailed analysis.
